- 1, The student must be ranked in the top 20% of the class (1st or 2nd decile)

3. Student must FULLY complete the application and return it to Sra. Kolodziej at Agawam High School (room 41) by **March 22, 2024**.
4. Student must bring financial aid package from the college to the interview

AEA 25-Week Club Scholarship

1. Parent must be an active 25 week club member and parent must be employed by Agawam public schools.
2. Student must be ranked in the top 25% of the class.
3. Student must be accepted to a four year college or university
4. Student must FULLY complete the application and return it to Sra. Kolodziej at Agawam High School (room 41) by **March 22, 2024**.
5. Student must bring financial aid package from the college to the interview
